## Our Training Program

We offer a 9-month training program in upcycled fashion sewing, leading to a diploma recognized by France Compétences in the form of the professional skills certificate no. RS6513, issued by the professional branch of couture.

We provide a real opportunity for everyone—students, job seekers, people in precarious situations or displaced persons—to receive training, acquire know-how, and re-enter the workforce.

Trainees learn sewing techniques and craftsmanship specific to couture within a functioning workshop. The training concludes with a fashion show

### Alaïa Collection

For weeks, Renaissance crafted a unique collection in collaboration with the House of Alaïa. Known for its rich Couture heritage, Alaïa entrusted Renaissance with pieces from past collections under Azzedine Alaïa's leadership, reimagined into new designs. Philippe Guilet, Renaissance's President and Founder, emphasized preserving Alaïa's DNA in the upcycled pieces while enjoying creative freedom for the rest. In October 2021, 15 looks debuted at a Paris dinner, followed by a London presentation on November 3. This collection marked the launch of Renaissance's Détox Ton Stock initiative, showcasing how Haute Couture houses can transform unsold stock.


